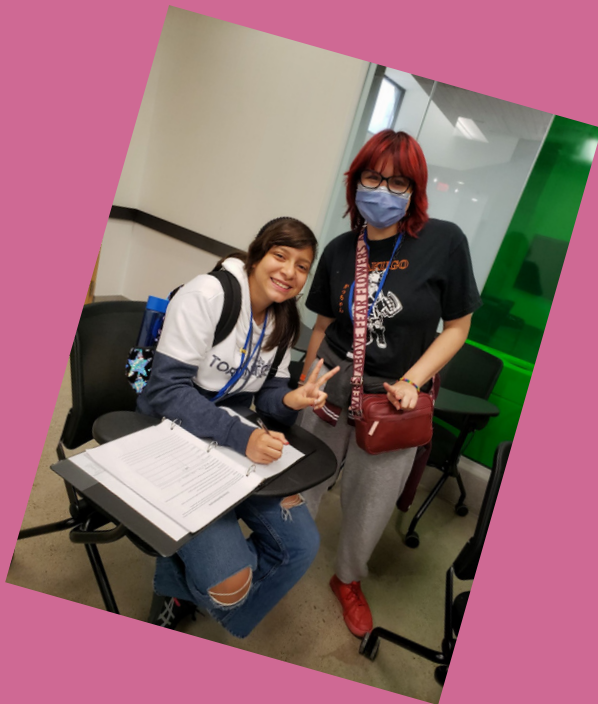
Son

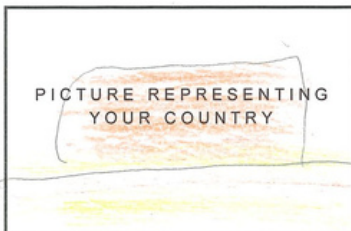

An interview about an aquarium



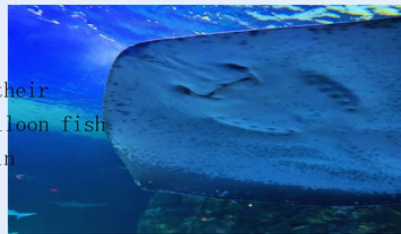
Everyone has different opinions of the aquarium.

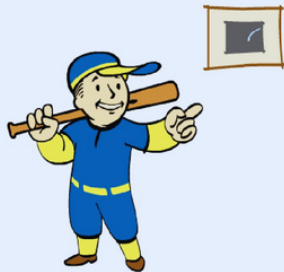
Basketball:
